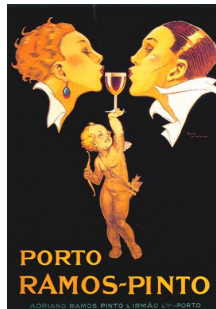
- 38 Red Muscat, Nuy, South Africa 3.95

Deep golden dessert wine with fresh citrus hints, good depth and a lasting syrupy sweet aftertaste. Full bodied on the palate.

Classic style late bottled port. Deep purple in colour with a warm and savoury flavour. Perfect with cheese it has good structure and fullness.
- 41 10 year old Tawny, Quinta da Ervamoira, Ramos Pinto 4.95
Aged ten years in barrel this tawny has a velvety smooth style. Showing a lighter colour with golden brown hints and a succulent richness to the finish. Good with cheese but will also sit well with chocolate or spongy desserts.
